THE SERIES

- Arkansas is 6-23 all-time against Vanderbilt
- The teams have met 13 times in Fayetteville (5-8), 15 times in Nashville (1-14) and once on a neutral court (0-1).
- Arkansas is 3-3 in true road games and 6-3 in games away from Bud Walton Arena.

GAME #18 VANDERBILT

- Arkansas' last win in Nashville a 68-64 victory over then No. 15 Vanderbilt Jan. 21, 2001. Arkansas defeated Vanderbilt in Bud Walton Arena Jan. 18, 2012, 69-47.
- Kelsey Brooks scored in double figures with 18 points for the 16th time in 18 games. Arkansas is 18-5 when Kelsey Brooks scores double figures.
- Arkansas suffered a nine-plus minute stretch going 0-for-18 to end the second half.

AT THE HALF

- Arkansas is 9-5 when leading at the half. The Razorbacks led Vanderbilt, 32-23 at the break.
- Arkansas has led at the half in five of six SEC games this season.
- Kelsey Brooks led Arkansas with eight points at the half.
- Arkansas led by as many as 12 and led by nine at the break.
- Arkansas led for the entire first half.
- Eight of nine players had a rebound in the first half.
- Arkansas shot 48.3 percent on 14-for-29 shooting in the first frame.

FOR STARTERS

- Today's Starters: Calli Berna, Kelsey Brooks, Melissa Wolff, Jessica Jackson, Jhasmin Bowen.
- Arkansas is 10-5 with this starting lineup.
- Arkansas did not win the tip.
- Jessica Jackson scored the first basket of the game with a step back three.
- Jessica Jackson played only eight minutes in the first half because of foul trouble.

OFF THE BENCH

- Freshman McKinley Bostad and junior Joey Bailey were the first players off the bench for Arkansas.
- Arkansas' bench scored seven points in the first half.
- All nine players played in the first half.

SEASON NOTES

- Arkansas is 7-6 all time in games on Jan. 22, including a 3-2 mark on an away court.

- As the 2014-15 campaign continues, Arkansas is in the midst of its 39th season of women's basketball, owning an overall program record of 703-442 (.614). In those 39 years, Arkansas has advanced to postseason play a total of 21 times, including 10 trips to the NCAA Tournament.
- 13 times in program history Arkansas has defeated multiple ranked opponents in the same season: 2011-12, 2010-11, 2005-06, 2002-03, 2001-02, 2000-01, 1998-99, 1996-97, 1995-96, 1994-95, 1993-94, 1990-91, 1985-86
- Last time Arkansas defeated two AP top 25 teams in the same season: 2011-12 - won a total of four games against ranked opponents. Defeated No. 13 Florida State 55-52 on Nov. 13, 2011, in the WBI Tip Off Classic in Daytona Beach, Fla. Defeated No. 25/22 Vanderbilt at home 69-47 on Jan. 19, 2012. Defeated No. 24/24 South Carolina 68-47 at home Feb. 9, 2012. Defeated No. 6/7 Tennessee 72-71 (OT) on the road Feb. 23, 2012.
- Last time Arkansas defeated two AP top 25 teams in the same season in games played away from home: 2011-12. Defeated No. 13 Florida State on Nov. 13, 2011, in the WBI Tip Off Classic in Daytona Beach, Fla. Defeated No. 6/7 Tennessee on the road Feb. 23, 2012

RECORDS WATCH

- Senior Calli Berna entered the season with 346 career rebounds and has 89 this season. She moved into the top 35 at Arkansas and currently ranks tied for 29th with 445 career boards.
- Senior Calli Berna moved into second place all-time in program history for assists against SDSU. She currently has 588 career assists, moving ahead of current Director of Basketball Operations Amber (Nicholas) Shirey, who has 538. The school record is held by Amy Wright (1998-02) who has 717 assists.
- Jessica Jackson has 731 career points ranking 38th overall.
- Calli Berna has 660 points ranking 44th all-time.
- Jhasmin Bowen has 713 career points ranking 39th all-time.
